Professor Stephen G Lomber

Professor of Physiology, Psychology, and Neuroscience at McGill University

Prof Stephen G. Lomber (B. Sc, Ph. D.) is a Professor of Physiology, Psychology, and Neuroscience at McGill University where he holds the Canada Research Chair in Brain Plasticity and Development. He received degrees in Neurobiology from the University of Rochester.

The goal of his team's research program is to advance understanding of how the auditory cortex responds to hearing loss and to the initiation of hearing with cochlear prosthetics.

They study these processes using an integrative approach of combining intervention methods (congenital deafness, induced hearing loss, and reversible cooling deactivation) with electrophysiological recording, psychophysical testing, and functional imaging.

His talk to us at the SACIG 2022 meeting promises to be fascinating!
